### DINNER THROUGH THE FIVE SENSES AT THE LILLAS PASTIA RESTAURANT

In a relaxed and peacefull atmosphere we make a sensorial journey of experiences and emotions. Let your imagination fly away with the company of an outstanding gastronomy.

### GASTRONOMIC ROUTE THROUGH HUESCA

A small itinerary aroud Huesca walking around the main monuments in the old town, full of stories, curiosities and anecdotes that will prepare the mood for the lugubrious and famous Huesca Bell.

But history is not all of it, the route will be sweetened by tasting different typical desserts of the city of Huesca.

The journey can be closed at the wine cellar of the “Ultramarinos La Confianza” shop, which is one of the oldest and best preserved grocery stores, opened since 1871.

### “KINGDOM OF HEAVEN” ROUTE

Just half an hour away from Huesca you can find one of the treasures of romanic art: the Loarre castle. Best preserved medieval fortress in Europe and setting chosen by the famous director Ridley Scott for his movie “Kingdom of Heaven”.





This unique and singular place located in the top of a limestone rock, 1070 metres high, is an excellent lookout to the of the plain of the Huesca bowl. The visit to this castle takes us to the Middle Ages, a time of battles, knights, and princesses where lords, kings and villains sighed to reach the “Kingdom of Heaven”.

To complete the visit we will have lunch or dinner at the Venta del Sotón restaurant, where we will be able to try a regional menu composed by “migas a la pastora”, “bacalao ajoarriero”, Huesca lamb and endless culinary delights of our region. Finally, the meal can be liven up by a folk “jotas”group.

### **MEDIEVAL VILLAGES AND “SOMONTANO” WINES**

The tour begins with the visit to the town of Aínsa, penetrate into this legendary medieval village, which was declared artistic-historical ensemble. No doubt, the best way to meet this town: walking around its streets, discovering its mansions, getting lost in its picturesque corners...those will be the means to take us to the past.

We will make a break to eat at the Callizo restaurant.

Trip to Alquézar, medieval town located at the Vero river’s last stretch, an impressive surrounding, setting that offers a great diversity of activities for nature and sport lovers too. During sunset

we will visit a selection of cellars producing Somontano certificate of origin wine.

**Prize per person: 60 €**

### **CHEESE TASTING: A MERGE OF FLAVOURS AND AROMAS**

Either at the Ultramarinos La Confianza wine cellar or the chocolate factory in Zaragoza.

Tasting of different traditional Aragonese cheeses, combined with regional wines. This will be alternated with the tasting of crystalized flowers, workshop where we will take a look to the inside of edible flowers.

Benabarre cheeses- Flor de Aspe cheese- Radiquero cheese- Sieso cheese- Albarracín cheese- freixneda de cabra cheese.

## SAN JUAN DE LA PEÑA, JACA AND ARAGÓN VALLEY

Tour devoted to the Aragón Kingdom's birthplace; early in the morning we will walk around Jaca, first capital of the Aragón Kingdom and arcade to the St. James' way.

After this the group will take a bus that will take them to the Benedictine Monastery of San Juan de la Peña, cultural and tourist banner of the Alto Aragón region. The small highlander village of Santa Cruz de la Serós will be visited too. There we will be able to see the singular San Caprasio temple, unique example of Lombardy romanico style.

Lunch at "El Boj" restaurant, which offers a natural season cuisine with a gourmet touch.

In the afternoon we will make a panoramic visit to the Aragón valley, through which one of the stretches of the St. James' way run. This itinerary allows us to enjoy the Pyrenean peaks, surrounded by meadows and lush forests. The emblematic Canfranc Train Station will be visited too.

## DAYTRIP TO ALBARRACÍN

Guided tour of Albarracín, walking around its streets, whose design adapt to the difficult topography of the land. Stairs, passages, and irregular walled mansions in tense balance, make of this town one of the considered "most beautiful in Spain".

Lunch at "El Batán" restaurant, which has recently been awarded with a Michelin star. Personal cuisine defined by its respect to the raw materials, but with a lot of creativity and modern and original techniques.

Visit to the cheese factory in Albarracín- where the cradle of ancient traditions followed by generations of shepherds and craftsmen to make one of the oldest foods, cheese, is found.

## MATARRAÑA ROUTE

Valderrobles is the most popular town in the Matarraña region. It was declared artistic-historical ensemble and perfectly preserves the medieval urban design. The itinerary begins from the medieval bridge, historical access that crosses the Matarraña river and the "Portal de San Roque". We will visit the old town stopping at the façades of the main civil buildings. And we will ascend to the monumental compound formed by the medieval castle and church, two of the "must see" in the matarraña region.

Calaceite. The cultural capital of Matarraña gives

us the opportunity to enjoy an excellent ensemble of medieval and modern stately mansions, with magnificent chapel-gates that access the village. The tour begins at the "Calle Mayor", main road leading into the square where the XVII century town hall, one of the best examples of civil Renaissance architecture, is found. The visit ends at the Juan Cabré museum (free entrance), archaeology pioneer in the Historical Bajo Aragón region during the XX century.

Lunch in Calaceite at the Fonda Alcalá.

**Prize per person: 65 €**
